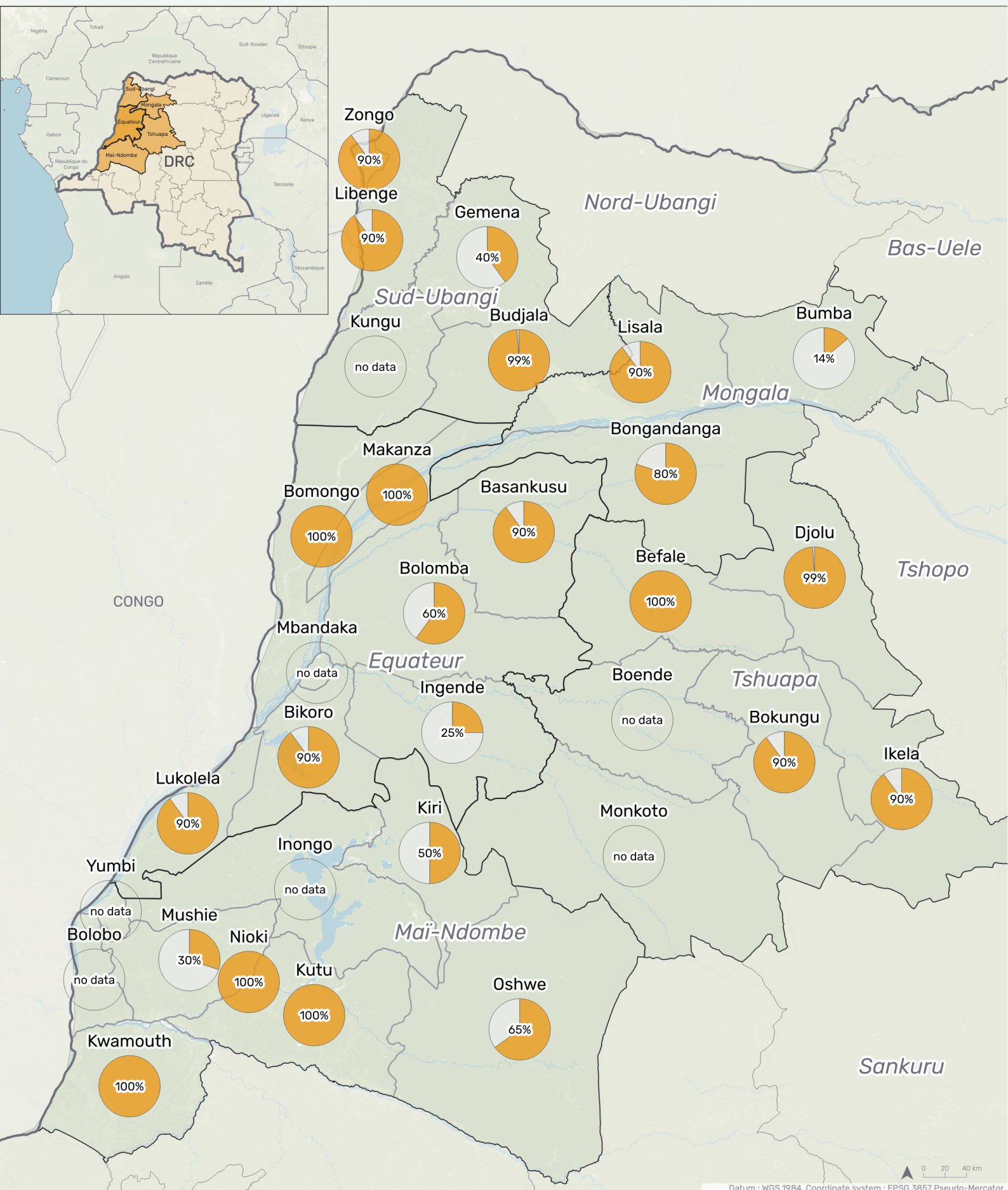


Language map of Équateur
