
Languages of Armenia other than Armenian





Percentage of population speaking languages other than Armenian as a first language

The 2011 census of Armenia records 16 main languages and dialects spoken in the country. The census indicates that Armenian is the most widely spoken as a first language (97% of the population), while Russian is the most spoken second language (89%). Kurmanji is the largest minority language in Armenia, spoken by 1.3% of the population, mostly in Armavir and Aragatsotn Provinces.
