

Language map of Benin

The census Translators without Borders. indicates that Fon is the most widely spoken as a first language (20% of the population), followed by Baatonum (9%) and Borgu Fulfulde (8%). Yom (2%) and Yoruba (1%) are considered national languages alongside Fon.
